

Irish Apple Cake

#### Ingredients:

#### Cake

- 1/2 cup unsalted butter at room temperature
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 2 <u>large eggs</u>
- 3 Tbsp whole milk or cream
- 1 1/4 cups all purpose flour
- 1 tsp <u>baking powder</u>
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/8 tsp <u>salt</u>
- about 3 Granny Smith apples, peeled and thinly sliced. About a pound after slicing.
- confectioner's sugar for dusting

#### Streusel topping

- 3/4 cup all purpose flour
- 1/4 cup old fashioned rolled oats
- 6 Tbsp unsalted cold butter cut in small pieces
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar

#### Custard sauce

- 6 large egg yolks
- 6 Tbsp granulated sugar
- 1 1/2 cups whole milk
- 1 1/2 tsp <u>vanilla</u>

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350F & grease a 9 inch pan.
- 2. Make custard sauce ahead of time. Bring milk to a simmer over medium heat. Whisk yolks and sugar until well combined. Drizzle hot milk into the egg mixture, whisking all the time. Transfer that back into the pan of hot milk and continue cooking, stirring constantly, until the mixture coats the back of a spoon. The mixture will become velvety and thick. It will continue to thicken as it cools, so don't overcook or it can curdle. Stir in the vanilla.
- 3. Pour custard through a sieve into a heat proof jar or bowl and place plastic wrap onto the surface so it won't form a skin as it cools. Refrigerate until cool
- 4. Streusel topping, blend bits of butter into the flour, sugar, and oats until the butter is incorporated and the mixture has a coarse crumbly texture. Refrigerate.
- 5. Cream together butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs, one at a time. Whisk together flour, baking powder, cinnamon, and salt. Fold dry ingredients into butter/sugar mixture, along with milk.
- Spoon batter into pan, and smooth. Top with sliced apples, and streusel topping.
- 7. Bake for about 50 minutes to an hour, until top is lightly browned and a toothpick comes out without wet batter clinging to it.
- Let cool. Dust with confectioner's sugar before serving.
